

The Waite Hill Land Conservancy ("WHLC") owning 297 acres of land in the Village has been committed to maintaining and preserving that acreage in its natural state for many, many years. In an effort to continue this stewardship, and after much thought and deliberation, the trustees of that organization thought that the best chance of perpetuating WHLC's legacy of stewardship and preserving the lands into the future was to merge with the Western Reserve Land Conservancy, which it did at the end of 2012. Conservation easements prohibiting any future development on those lands were filed as a part of the transaction and the Western Reserve Land Conservancy assumes stewardship of the property into the future.
