

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-5

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That effective April 1, 2012, full time members of the Police Department shall receive a base salary pursuant to the following schedule, plus other compensation provided by law, if applicable.

	<u>Annual Base Salary</u>
Chief of Police	\$ 65,000.00 – 82,000.00
Sergeant	\$ 66,069.12
	<u>Maximum Annual Base Salary</u>
Patrolmen	\$ 60,062.88

SECTION 2. That effective April 1, 2012, part-time members of the Police Department shall receive an hourly rate of compensation as follows:

	<u>Hourly Compensation Maximum</u>
Part-time Patrolmen	\$21.73

SECTION 3. That effective April 1, 2012, all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 4. That the compensation authorized by this Ordinance shall be in addition to other compensation to the aforementioned employees provided by other legislation.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Waite Hill and, further, provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
