

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-6

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL TO
CHANGE CERTAIN APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
DECEMBER 31, 2016, REPEALING CERTAIN
ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL,
LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2015-17, passed December 14, 2015, be amended to change appropriations in the following general fund line item to the following amounts:

<u>General Fund</u>	
Police- Equipment Repair & Maintenance	\$5,000.00
<u>Capital Fund</u>	
Capital Expenditures (Police Car)	\$44,500.00
Capital Expenditures (Metcalf Road Project)	\$185,000.00

SECTION 2. That all ordinances, or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Waite Hill and, further, provides for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
