

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-12

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE CURRENT REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE WAITE HILL CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revisions which is presently before Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAITE HILL, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the ordinances of the Village of Waite Hill, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2012 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

That the ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the current Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements; wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
